Public Health Guide

May 2022

*This guidance applies to all Larimer County grounds:

REQUIRED

- **COVID Reporter:** all faculty, staff and students are **required** to tell the CSU Public Health office without delay if they:
 - test positive (even via a home test)
 - believe they have been exposed
- **Vaccines:** COVID vaccines or an exemption are required for all students, faculty and staff *regardless of work location (both within and outside of Larimer County)
- **Camps and childcare facilities:** all attendees, including minors, volunteers, staff are required to report positive tests, symptoms or exposure through the COVID Reporter.

OPTIONAL

- **Masks:** masks are not required, but anyone who wants to wear a mask may do so
- **Physical distancing:** is not required in any location
- **Boosters:** are encouraged but not required
